



Cooperative Agreements for Sucker Egg Collection 2011

Dear Fish Farmer,

We will start accepting requests for 2011 Sucker Cooperative Agreements from Fish Farmers **no earlier** than March 14th 2011. To request an agreement please provide the local fisheries biologist for the county the waterbody is located in the following information. Agreements will be awarded on a first come, first served basis. In the case of a tie, the total number of eggs the resource can provide will be split between the Fish Farmers seeking an agreement. The Department will not issue agreements on waters that are known to be infected or suspected to be infected with Viral Hemorrhagic Septicemia. Please refer to this website http://dnr.wi.gov/fish/vhs/vhs_widistribution.html to see a map of waters that are in these two classes. Disinfection of eggs is a requirement of the agreement. A sample copy of an agreement is attached.

Mail this completed document to the fisheries biologist that serves the county you wish to collect eggs in. The addresses for all fisheries biologists are attached to this document.
